

VETERINARY LICENSE AND PERMIT FEES

Persons engaged in the practice of veterinary medicine must be licensed as required by the Veterinary Practice Act (61-14-18).

Veterinarian:

- State examination fee: \$300, bi-annual dates scheduled in January and May;
- State examination fee for endorsement: \$500;
- State examination fee: \$500, on date other than bi-annual dates in January and May;
- 60-day temporary permit: \$250;
- National examination sponsorship fee (NAVLE): \$65;
- Annual license renewal fee: \$200;
- Late penalty, \$100 first month; thereafter, \$100 plus license fee plus \$10 per day not to exceed \$3000. Contact Executive Director for exact amount.
- Verifications of licensure: \$25 per state.

Registered Veterinary Technician:

- State examination fee: \$75, bi-annual dates scheduled in January and May;
- State examination fee: \$100, on date other than bi-annual dates in January and May;
- National examination sponsorship fee (VTNE): \$50;
- Annual renewal fee: \$75;
- Late penalty: postmarked after December 31, \$25; thereafter \$25 plus license fee plus \$5 per day not to exceed \$300. Contact Executive Director for exact amount.
- Verifications of licensure: \$25 per state.

Artificial Insemination and Pregnancy Diagnosis Technicians:

- Annual permit fee: AI: \$75; PD: \$75 for PD;
- Late fee: postmarked after December 31, \$50; thereafter, \$75 plus permit fee

Veterinary Facility:

- Initial application fee and annual renewal fee: \$125;
- Change in licensee manager or physical address: \$125;
- Late penalty: postmarked after September 30, \$50; thereafter, \$125 plus license fee.

License Reinstatement Requirements:

Within five years:

- Late fee penalty plus current year renewal fee. Contact Executive Director for exact amount.

After five years:

- Original application requirements including re-take of state examination.
